Now

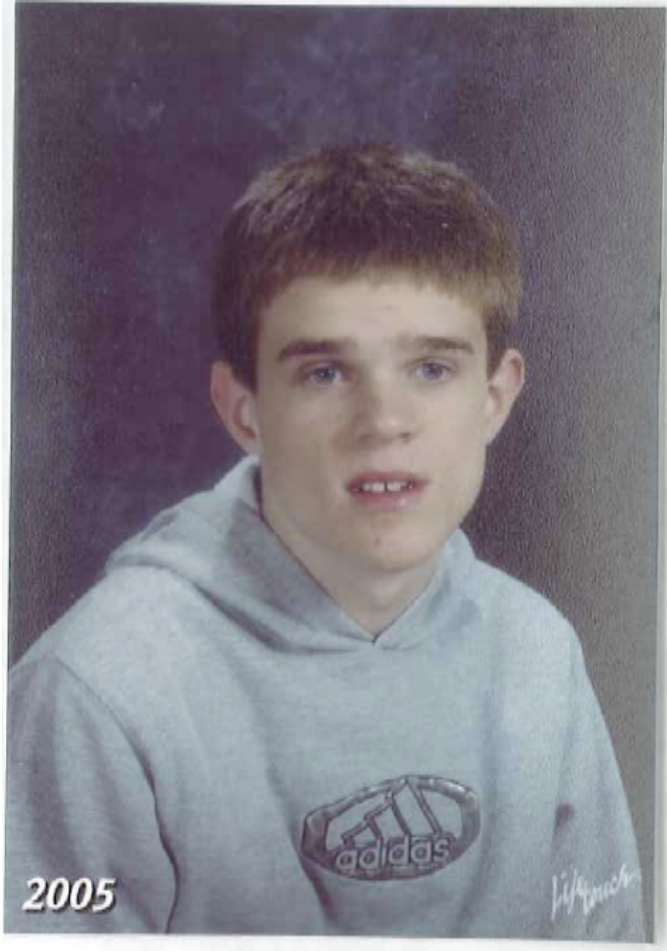
When we asked him what he wants to eat in the past he would give a list of the GFCF foods he could have there but again never a direct answer. Now he is just saying exactly what he wants to eat.

His teacher again mentioned to be that she is seeing his understanding of everything really changing. When she is asking him a question he is "getting it" and giving correct responses and reading still continues to improve.
